<p>The Cornucopia Project brings children into gardens — and gardens into the lives of families — to promote an understanding of where vital and healthy food comes from and the importance and beauty of the Earth’s bounty. Kids learn cooperation, teamwork, respect for the land, the value of hard work, and knowledge of where their food comes from. The kids will also gain a pride in their accomplishments – the fruits and vegetables of their labor! – and an appreciation for food that cannot be matched.</p>

<p>Garden Gorillas focus on integrating gardening activities, such as planting, hoeing, weeding, and watering, with playing activities, such as games, stories, drawing, and singing. The kids love putting together a farmer’s market for their families, keeping watch on the plants that they’ve planted, and eating chives and peas straight off the plant. Other activities include a garden scavenger hunt, singing, make-your-own napkin with pressed leaves from the garden, and making a "compost lasagna" to teach them about composting.</p>

During Farm Explorer week camper have scavenger hunts in the garden, cook seasonal meals and dig deep into the soil and life that nourishes our bodies. There will be plenty of time for hiking, games and exploring the pond.</p>

<p>Enjoy summer days filled with fun, farming and friendship! The Stonewall Farm camp program introduces campers to the diverse world of organic agriculture, and the unique role farms play in our daily lives. Farm experiences are blended with nature study and traditional camp favorites to create a unique program for campers ages 4 - 15.</p> <p>Campers spend their days in coed groups of 10 or less campers and two counselors. Staff members are all experienced educators who enjoy sharing their love of the outdoors and the farm with children. All staff are certified in First Aid and CPR, and undergo legal background checks. Small group sizes and small camp of only 70 campers creates an intimate setting where wholesome experiences keep our rural traditions alive.</p>

<p><b>Ramblers:</b> entering grades 1 &amp; 2 (6 - 7 yr. olds)  6 sessions (5 days M-F) starting July 5, July 12, July 19, July 26, August 2, and August 9  Begin each day with farm chores, then enjoy a sampling of all the farm has to offer, from the barns to the garden to the kitchen. Camp crafts, traditional games and nature hikes are all a part of this exciting program.</p> <p><b>Pioneers:</b> entering grades 3 &amp; 4 (8 - 9 yr. olds)  6 sessions (5 days M-F) starting July 5, July 12, July 19, July 26, August 2, and August 9  Pioneer campers expand their understanding of the role farms play in our everyday lives as they continue their explorations of our gardens and animals as a food and fiber source. Camp crafts, recipes and adventures into the surrounding natural areas will deepen the Pioneers' understanding of the importance of farms and farmland to local communities and wildlife. Pioneers have the option of staying for our Thursday night campout!</p> <p><b>Explorers:</b> entering grades 5 &amp; 6 (10 - 11 yr. olds)  4 sessions (5 days M-F) starting July 12, July 19, August 2, and August 9  As your camper matures, so does the level and intensity at which they get to experience the farm. An Explorer will have the opportunity to learn more about the jobs and specific skills required to be a farmer. It's not all work of course, we'll be sure to include plenty of time for keeping cool by the creek, and hiking our forested trails. Explorers also have a Thursday night overnight option.</p> <p><b>Wanderers:</b> entering grades 7 - 9 (12 -14 yr. olds)  2 sessions (5 days M-F) starting July 12 and July 19  This leadership based program focuses on the self as part of a group, as it continues to explore the intricate details of the farm and its important work. From team driving, to farm stand management, they'll experience the real work of Stonewall Farm and lend a helping hand! Wanderers who show a strong dedication and interest in the mission and traditions of our summer camp will be given special consideration when applying to our Counselor-in-Training Program.</p>
