OJT Paths to Success

NEG OJT

National Emergency Grant

Employer reimbursed

50-90% of wages paid to trainee with no cap

Under 50 Employees: 75-90%

51-250 Employees: **50-75**%

251 or more: 50%

FORMULA OJT

Employer reimbursed **50%** of wages paid to trainee with a \$4,000 cap

- Up to \$21.02 per hour
- Up to 6 months of training

Continued long-term, unsubsidized <u>full-time</u> employment for successful OJT trainees

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Trainee Eligibility Requirements

FORMULA OJT

- 18 years or older, laid-off with prolonged unemployment
 (18 weeks or more)
- No interim employment
- Laid off on or after1/1/2008
- 18 years or older, unemployed and in need of services to find employment; OR employed but in need of services to retain or obtain employment that allows for selfsufficiency.

Individuals who have been laid off for <u>less than 18 weeks and/or have</u> received interim employment may be eligible for the WIA OJT.

OJTs are for full-time positions only.

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
