We sell high-quality products that are grown, sewn, beaded, knit, carved, blown, fired, written, printed, cured, baked, or painted in the Region from over 300 members.

In 2006 we expanded with the Hannah Grimes Center, which is at 25 Roxbury Street and assists our members with business education, support, coaching and additional resources.

Steps to become a member - it's as simple as:

- 1. Fill out application.
- 2. Return the completed application with your retail-ready sample (s) to the marketplace. If your product is food, please include a copy of your kitchen/food service license and Product Liability Insurance.
- 3. The Jury meets the 1^{st} week of each month we do NOT jury in December.

Should your product be accepted:

- 1. You will receive a "Welcome Packet" with information regarding further membership details and a consignment agreement.
- 2. Before any product is placed in the Marketplace for sale you need to provide us with:
 - a. Completed Consignment Agreement
 - b. Artisan Biography
 - c. Digital Photographs of your work or yourself
 - d. Completed invoice for your merchandise
 - e. Appropriate packaging/label/pricing
- 3. You will need to attend our Marketplace 101 within 3 months of membership.
